The global market for maritime equipment amounts to approximately 60 bn. euro

More than 30% is produced in Europe

Did you know that

The maritime industry's total value increment directly and indirectly in EU amounts to 111 bn. euro of which 90% takes place in the production company

In EU 33% of the direct value increment in the maritime industry is transferred to the state in form of taxes and duties etc.

In EU 83% of the direct value increment is used for European purchases

Did you know that

Hempel is the only independent European supplier of paint in Korea

The roof on the Sport Arena Parken in Copenhagen is a steel construction produced by Bladt Industries

Mærsk Container Industry is the only producer in Europe of maritime refrigerator containers

Every year 75 million ISO standard containers all over the world are loaded and unloaded
